A Happy New Year to you all! Now we are half way through the season, here is another bulletin for you to keep you upto date with the news from CJFC.

## Subscriptions – Club Fees

Thank you to all whom paid their subscriptions for the season and on time! If you are unsure or have any questions regarding subs please contact your admin assistant or Julie McEntee.

However, there are a small number of subscriptions outstanding. Term 2 (January-End of Season) subs need to be paid by **31st January 2010**. You will be contacted directly if you are owing term 2 subs.

Failure to pay outstanding subs by this date will restrict players from being selected for their team until it is paid. **Club policy state, a player will be suspended by the club from training and being selected from matches if fees are not paid by the deadline.**

In addition players who have not paid subscriptions are not registered members of the club which also means they are NOT covered by any of the clubs insurance.

Subs fees are **£35 per term#** for the first family member and £30 per term for the second and each subsequent family member.
